Vanessa's Story

Meet Vanessa. One year ago her sister Lindsay was raped. Vanessa was the only person that her sister told about the situation. Vanessa tried everything she could to be there for her sister, and tried to find her the help she needed. After Lindsay's trauma and pain built up, she ended her life a few weeks after she was raped. Vanessa carries the burden of not being able to help her sister. Knowing how much she was suffering, Vanessa's guidance counselor told her about Project HELP. Vanessa receives counseling from the victim advocates at Project HELP to ease the pain of her sister's tragic story of both rape and suicide. If Vanessa would have known about Project HELP before her sister ended her life, there could have been someone Lindsay could have talked to, someone that would understand what she was going through.

Project HELP Needs Your HELP

After being in Collier County for over 25 years, Project HELP still struggles with community awareness. The services offered could save lives, but the subject matter of Project HELP is difficult to promote. Our goal, through fundraising and community awareness, is to make Project HELP a household name; a name that nobody ever hopes to call on, but one that everybody knows to call on if help is needed dealing with difficult and painful event.

So far this year, Project Help has answered 936 Rape Hotline calls, performed 5,334 new client services, and continued 11,394 ongoing client services.
