Project HELP is a non-profit organization of professional counselors and advocates committed to providing hope, empowerment, and healing to those affected by sexual violence, sudden death, and other crimes. Along with counseling and advocacy services, Project HELP serves our community by providing a 24-Hour Crisis & Referral Hotline at (239) 262-7227.

Mission Statement: Project HELP works with dignity and compassion to ease the pain of those affected by rape, violence, crime or loss of a loved one.

Founded in: 1986...30 years ago.

Collier County's only state-certified rape and victim of violent crime crisis center.

Operates a 24/7 multi-language hotline at 239-262-7227.

All services are provided for free.

Services include: immediate response to sexual assault and crime victims; forensic exams for sexual assault victims; human trafficking intervention; child abuse intervention; sudden death notification; grief counseling and suicide survivor counseling for victims and families; guidance through the judicial system; referral for funds and services available to victims; coordination for additional services such as temporary housing, medical care, clothing and job assistance.

Annual statistics:

- Assists an average of 2,000 new clients
- Provides more than 6,000 client hours
- Answers 2,000 calls to the 24/7 hotline

Staff of 6: executive director, 5 victim advocate counselors, and 1 victim advocate administrative support.

Contract support: Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner, and marketing consultant.

Volunteers: board of directors, medical director, hotline volunteers, and special events committee.

Budget: \$350,000 annually.

Funding: staff salaries (not including insurance) and a very small portion of office expenses are covered by federal and state programs such as the Victims of Crime Act, Rape Crisis Trust Fund and State of Florida General Revenue Fund for Sexual Assault. Additional support is necessary through donations from individuals, businesses, foundations and grant making organizations.

Major fundraisers: Presentation of the Vagina Monologues (April) and Chocolate Extravaganza (fall).
